



Lowest point: Lake Maggiore, 193m a.s.l.





You grew up in your hotel. What was that like?

The regular guests were like part of our family, so I had something like 20 aunts and uncles. My brother and I would show our guests the romantic thermal spa district.

Which part is particularly nostalgic?

Our good old Schindler lift – one of the first in the world. It may look old, but the working mechanism is state of the art.

Do you have a favourite spot in the building?

The chaise longue on the fourth floor. You can see the sky through the glass roof and the atrium below with all its galleries and greenery.

Built in 1557, the historic **Schloss Wartegg** has a splendid park with an organic wild herb garden. The delicate plants are freshly harvested and transformed into delicacies in the castle restaurant.
